The Road Safety Club of Government College Barotiwala organized an Enrolment and Awareness Drive on 16th September 2025 at the Main Entrance of the college. The programme began with a lecture on road safety, where students were sensitized about the importance of following traffic rules for their own safety and that of others. Afterwards, all present took a pledge on road safety, reaffirming their commitment to becoming responsible road users.
