SAR (Self-Assessment Report) 2024-25

The Directorate of Higher Education, Himachal Pradesh, introduced an Internal Ranking System for state colleges, establishing seven criteria with assigned scores. Each college was tasked with preparing a Self-Assessment Report (SAR), which was subject to evaluation by a Cluster-level committee.



As part of this initiative, a Cluster-level committee, chaired by Dr. Sunita Sharma, Principal of Government College Arki, conducted a physical verification of our college's SAR on 21st November 2024. This inspection aimed to ensure the accuracy of the report and assess the college's alignment with the prescribed criteria. **The College secured 32nd position out of 66 colleges among Tier – 3 institutions in the state.**
